**Self-esteem, locus of control and emotional control of adolescent daughters of alcohol dependent fathers**

**Summary**

An important problem of the family environment is the detrimental influence of alcohol abusing parents on their children's personality development. Thus, the aim of this study was to assess some „self” structures in adolescent girls from families with the alcohol problem. Variables under study were measured using a number of questionnaires: the Self-Knowledge Inventory, Locus of Control Questionnaire, and Emotional Control Scale. Subjects in the study were 30 adolescent daughters of alcohol dependent fathers and 30 pair-matched daughters of fathers without alcohol dependence. Obtained results indicate that daughters of alcohol dependent fathers significantly more frequently manifest a low self-esteem, external locus of control, and a low level of emotional control. Our findings are concordant with data reported by other authors.
